

LYTTON FIRST NATION NOTICE TO MEMBERS

LYTTON FIRST NATION CUSTOM COMMUNITY ELECTION LAW

REFERENDUM VOTE ON MAY 17, 2018

A custom election law is being proposed by the Lytton First Nation ("LFN"). If the *LFN Custom Community Election Law* is passed by membership, then the LFN Council elections will no longer be subject to the *Indian Act*. The *LFN Custom Community Election Law* will govern all elections for LFN Chief and Council. This draft law was developed based upon the feedback and recommendations Chief and Council received from membership over the last few years.

THE BALLOT QUESTION

1. Are you in favour of replacing the *Indian Act* election rules and Indian Band Election Regulations with the *Lytton First Nation Custom Community Election Law*? Yes/No

VOTING ELIGIBILITY

All Lytton First Nation Band Members that are 18 years or older are eligible to vote. You have the option to vote in person during the times listed below, or request a mail-in ballot. Please bring your status card or other photo I.D. to cast your vote at a polling station.

POLLING STATION

The referendum is being conducted on **May 17, 2018**. All voters may vote in-person at the following date/location:

8:00 am – 8:00 pm

MAIL-IN BALLOTS

All voters who live off reserve, and for whom the First Nation has an address, will automatically be mailed a mail-in ballot package.

Those voters who live on reserve and are unable to vote in-person on [insert date] may ***request a Mail-In Ballot Package by no later than April 27, 2018 by contacting the Electoral Officer.***

Mail in Ballots must be received by May 16, 2018.
